Title: Approval by the Board of Education of Amendment No. 2, Professional Services Contract between the District and PMA Consulting, Oakland, CA, for the latter to provide an additional 110 hours of services, with Media Center Consultant meeting with small groups of students weekly, impacting 140 students, addressing National Technology Standards and State ELA and Math Standards to support gains on standardized tests as outlined in the School Site Plan; provide FBB-B students motivating hands-on experiences using the computer to practice ELA and math skills, so that they will be better able to benefit from regular grade level classroom instruction; provide EL newcomers direct English instruction by having hand-on experiences using the Rosetta Stone and other ELD software as evidenced by improved CELDT scores; and provide fourth and fifth grade GATE students project-based learning through use of the computer, including an interview and production of a magazine on endangered animals' at Laurel Elementary School, for the period of December 7, 2010 through May 30, 2011, in an additional amount of \$5,435.30, increasing Contract not to exceed amount from \$18,280.00 to \$23,715.30. All other terms and conditions of the Contract remain in full force and effect.
