methodology; conduct in classroom demonstrations and coach upper grade teachers on visual arts teaching techniques; confer with teachers on lesson plans which integrate the Visual Arts, in an additional amount of \$9,855.00, increasing contract from \$4,320.00 to an amount not to exceed \$14,175.00 and extending the contract period of November 20, 2008 to December 31, 2008 to June 11, 2009 at Laurel Elementary School.
