Title: Approval by the Board of Education of a Memorandum of Understanding between the District and Alameda County Community Food Bank, Oakland, CA, for the latter to provide three programs: Backpack Program - participating schools receive pre-packed bags on a bi-monthly basis for 36 weeks of the school year; Mobile Pantry Program - the Mobile Pantry model is a once a monthly or bi-monthly delivery distribution in a farmer's market style, client-choice distribution using a refrigerated truck; and the Fixed Pantry Program - the Fixed Pantry model is a weekly, bi-weekly or monthly delivery of food depending on school choice, need and capacity, at Esperanza, Fred T. Korematsu Discovery Academy, Garfield, Global Family, Greenleaf, Howard, Laurel, Lincoln, and Reach Academy Elementary Schools, Elmhurst Community Preparatory, Frick Impact Academy, West Oakland and Westlake Middle Schools, Fremont, Oakland International, Oakland Technical and Skyline High Schools, and the Central Family Resource Center, for the period of August 13, 2017 through August 13, 2020, at no cost to the District.
