- *All* BUILD classes will be offered during the day and 100% of HS students take Pathway CTE course.

- Junior and Senior Seminar courses focus on post-secondary education plans.

- All students at GSP receive social emotional curriculum from Yale's RULER program. This program is integrated throughout contact classes and explicitly taught in Advisory classes.

- Embedded special education and English learner supports
- Junior and Senior Seminar courses taught by College & Career Readiness Teacher and supported by Academic Counselor.
