1st Middle School Meeting

- 18 students from 5 middle schools: Claremont, Edna Brewer, Bret Harte, Urban Promise Academy (UPA), Frick United
- Frick United Hosted Frick Student Leaders gave us a welcome, provided activities for students to get to know each other, and shared an activity they do within leadership: Mindful Moments
- Students got to know leaders from across the Middle Schools present, reviewed case studies about student-led movements in OUSD, got an understanding of what Action Planning and Action Projects are, and started brainstorming what they would like to address this year
 - Some issues that students came up with (and are interested in addressing):
 - **Bathrooms**
 - Safety/Security
 - **Quality of Teachers**
 - Inclusivity/Student-Student Relationships/Racial Slurs
- Next Middle School Meeting is in December at Edna Brewer










Youth Candidate Forum

- About 135 people in attendance
- Questions for candidates were related to shared decision making, school food, mental health, school safety, school closures/consolidations, student homelessness, and restorative justice
- 82 attendees participated in mock voting (majority were students)


Newly Elected GB Members
