Referrals to Wellness services entered by staff, parents, or students themselves

School Social Worker (Sara Zamudio)

- Small groups to support: newcomers, social skills, anxiety
- Psycho-social education to parents, staff, students
- Case management for families
- Member of Attendance/SART team
- Crisis intervention

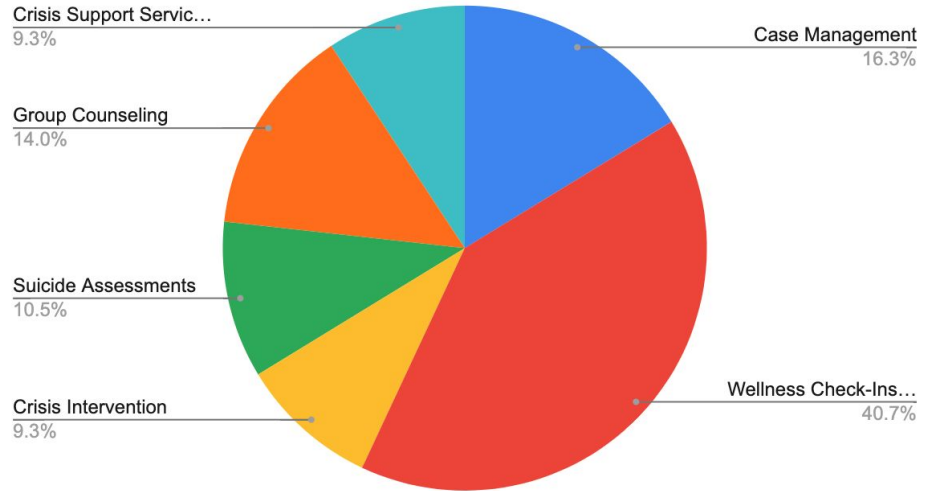
Refer student to counseling intern

# Goal #1: Maintain high number/percentage of students referred for mental health services being served, maintain 0% of students on the waiting list.

- 78 students received 1-on-1 Wellness support including crisis intervention, suicide risk assessment, individual counseling, and case management
- Utilizing 2 counseling interns, 1 AMFT
- Maintained 0 students on the waiting list

# Goal #2: Decrease number and percentage of suspensions and expulsions

- In 2021-2022, we had a 4% suspension rate.
- In 2022-23, we had a 0% suspension rate.



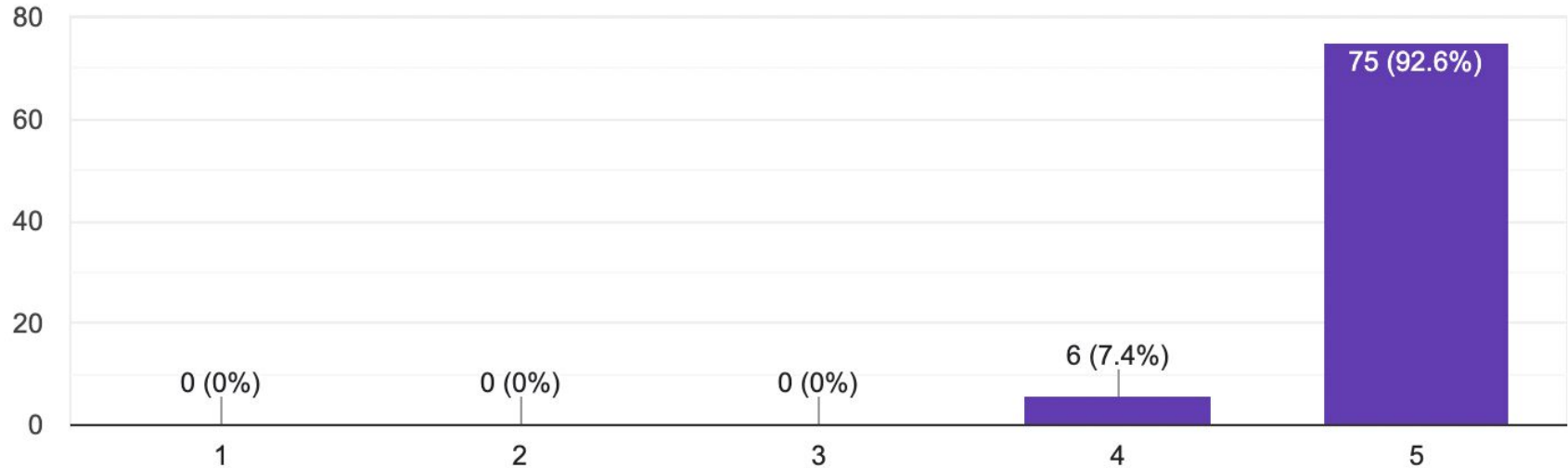
# **Goal #3:** Maintain high satisfaction with school climate and safety by parents/guardians, staff and students

  - Students (95 responses)



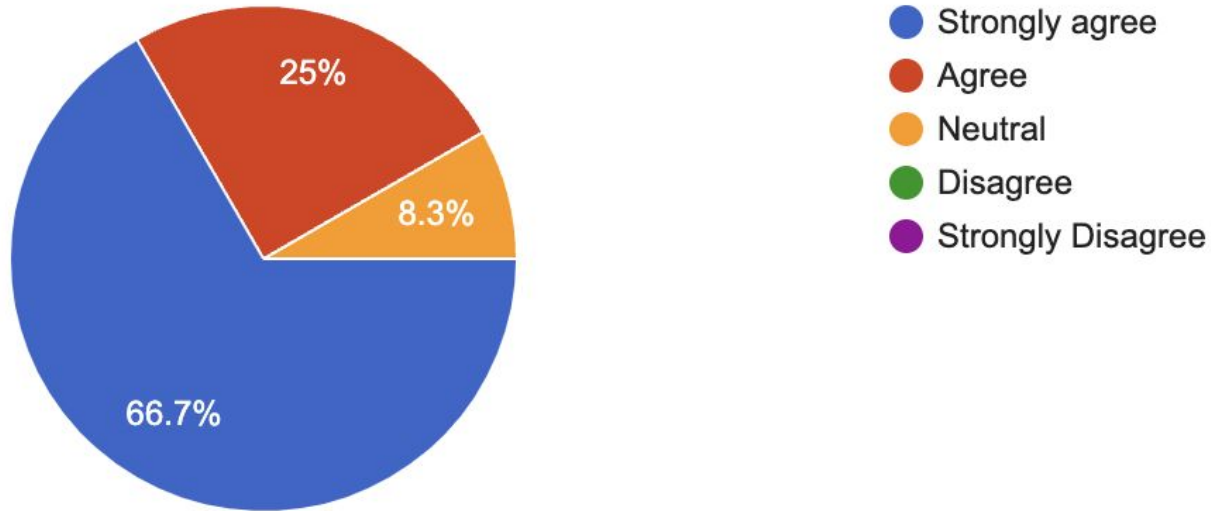
# Parent Survey Results- 81 responses (65% of families)

# Staff Survey Results- 12 responses

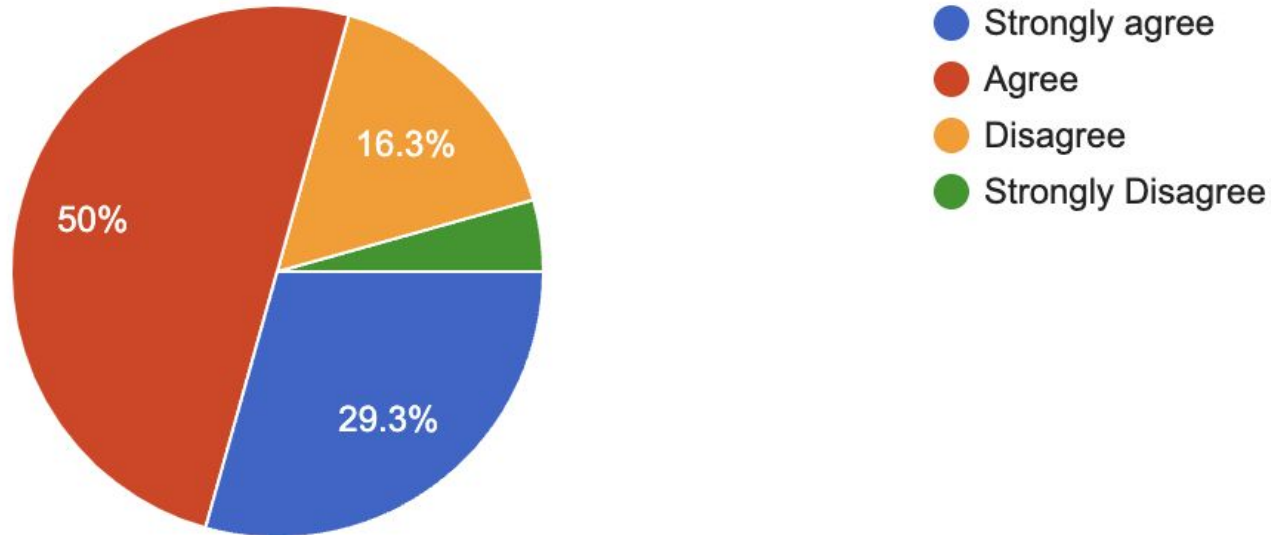
The school has invested in and developed practice of Restorative Justice.



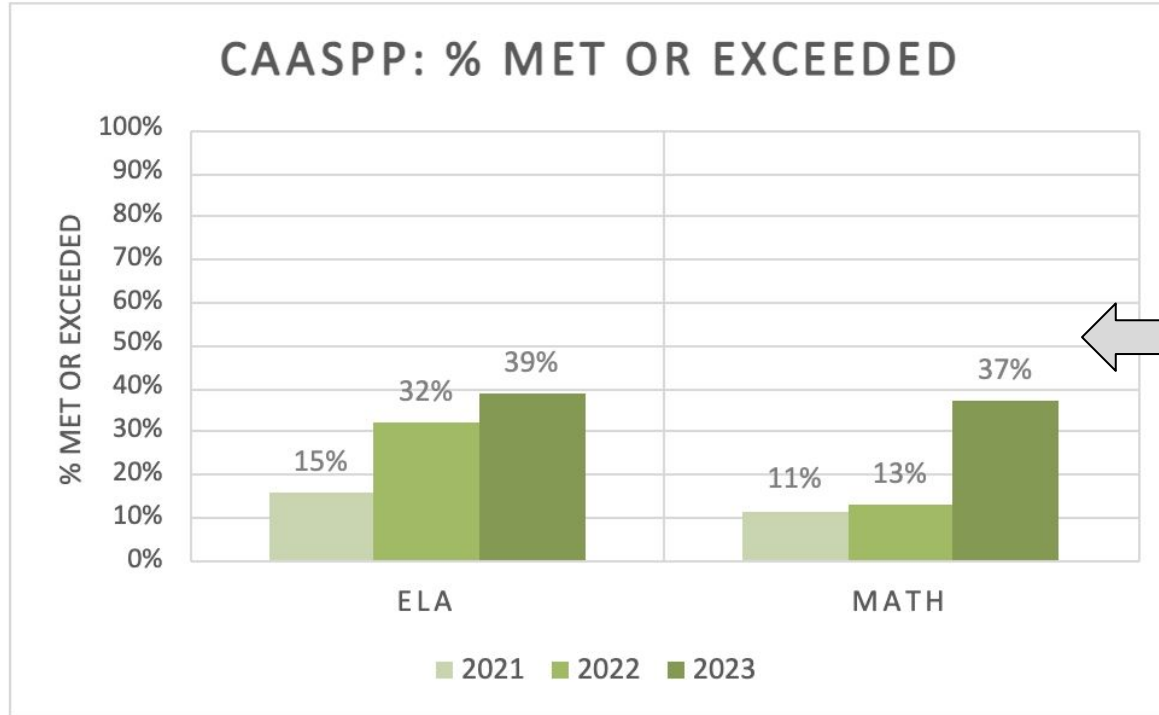


# Student Survey Results- 95 responses
