ACC Annual Peer Resource and Ethnic Studies Conference

- This year All City Council's Peer Resource and Ethnic Studies Conference was held on March at Mills College
 - The theme this year was "You Can't Spell Justice Without U and I"
 - 100+ middle school attendees from Claremont, Edna Brewer, Elmhurst United, Life Academy, Urban Promise Academy, United for Success Academy, West Oakland Middle, Westlake
 - The conference was an all day event that was student led with adult allie support
- Students engaged in & led:
 - Opening ceremony
 - Restorative justice circles
 - Student workshops - facilitated by Edna Brewer Peer RJ program, AYPAL: Building API Community Power, Oakland Youth Commission, Youth ALIVE!, All City Council, and OUSD's Health & Wellness Department
- Workshops targeted exploring:
 - Identity, culture, Arts and crafts, Build on their leadership skills, Creating community
- 100% of RJ community building circles were led by middle school students; 65% of all workshops were led by middle school students; 35% of all workshops were co-led by high
