
Schoolwide Systems Supporting Pathway Quality Improvement

- Fully-staffed academic counseling and wellness counseling team
- O Common planning time for CTE and academic teachers
- Reducing from two pathways to one
- In-person teaching

Other highlights:

- O Graduation rate increase from 88.4% to 94.6% (from 21-22 to 22-23)
- Male 4-year cohort graduation rate increase from 88% to 91% (from 21-22 to 22-23)
- O Dual enrollment grades of C- or better increase from 50% in 21-22, to 57% in 22-23, to a range of 75% to 100% in Sem 1 in 23-24
- o FAFSA application rate 68% (23-24)
 - Male 4-year cohort graduation rate increase from 88% to 91% (from 21-22 to 22-23)

 - **34** 12th grade students enrolled in DVMA courses Sem 1
 - **33** 12th grade students enrolled in DVMA courses Sem 2





Reflections on 2023-24

Criterion 1: Measures N and H Pathway Improvement Progress Reflection: What has your reflection revealed about progress toward your strategic goals? What progress is evident in your school's reflection on Year 1 (2022-23) strategic actions?

- We have made great improvements in our whole school enabling conditions, including establishing a stable leadership team, increasing the number of in-person classes, and investing in teacher capacity-building initiatives.
- Our Integrated Program of Study is revised to reflect Linked Learning Standards as well as the feedback from the students and education partners.
- Students are participating in the REEL internship, the Construction News Group internship, and the Headwaters Research internship. Career Launch curriculum is infused throughout pathway classes.
- We have a fully-staffed, credentialled academic counseling and wellness team.















Reflections on 2023-24

Criterion 2: Measures N and H Pathway Improvement Plan (Actions): What new or revised strategic actions will the school and pathways undertake in the coming year to continue to make progress toward three-year goals? How will these actions impact student achievement and experience to improve school-wide goals?

- Implement professional development programs aimed at fostering the creation of cross-curricular projects, enhancing student capstone portfolio development, and facilitating pathway learning outcome exhibitions.
- Establish the LPS Oakland Linked Learning Advisory Board with the primary objective of synchronizing Pathway Student Learning Outcomes (PSLO) with the graduate profile.
- Strategically develop Career and Technical Education (CTE) pathway certificates through both local initiatives and partnerships with the Peralta Colleges, aimed at providing comprehensive vocational training and credentialing opportunities to our community.
- Advance Work-Based Learning (WBL) initiatives by sustaining student work experience through the Career Launch curriculum,
 offering credits for Work Experience Education, and collaborating with industry partners to expand the availability of Internships
 and Apprenticeships.
- Collaboratively design Capstone exhibitions to showcase student-produced products from their Linked Learning experiences, highlighting the practical skills and knowledge directly transferable to pathway related post-secondary opportunities and options.

- Use data to inform nimble shifts as needed












