I hope that this letter finds you well. I want to thank you and your office for your ongoing support of programs and youth development. In particular for your support of the Oakland Manufacturing Day Event. This year we again had a great event.

This year we again had 8 manufacturing sites and 8 OUSD Schools participate in the event. The schools included Madison Park Academy, Castlemont, Fremont, McClymonds, Oakland High, Oakland Tech, Rudsdale and Skyline High Schools. And our host sites were: Akash Systems, Brimstone, ERG Aerospace, Everett Graphics, MN Builders, Pyka, Rainin and Rock the Bike.

This is a good situation with a financial impact. The two major costs for this event is the lunch that is provided for the students and staff, and the transportation to get the students to the manufacturing sites and to Laney College. I am pleased to share that Laney College, despite budgetary cuts, provided the food for the event.

I have contacted Bus Loop, who is one of the OUSD approved charter bus companies. They gave me a quote of \$5,100, \$1,275 per bus.
