Impacts

- Builder Projected Change Orders extended general conditions, material escalation, labor increases, unforeseen conditions.
 Environmental/Utilities, additional testing and inspections, DSA fees, etc.
- **City Improvements** including upgrades to Sidewalk, street, curb cuts, SS lines.
- Remedial Action Work Plan (RAW) removal & replacement of contaminated soil at varying depths 1', 2.5', & 4'.
- Includes \$1.6M Project Contingency


