LISTENING TO STUDENT & COMMUNITY VOICES

Lead Contamination

- Student Voice & Concerns

Kaylena Vuong (OUSD Student) - “Lead contamination is extremely harmful, especially when occurring within schools. From a psychological standpoint, lead exposure can contribute to mental health problems such as anxiety, and depression. For the overall community, those exposed to lead may experience high levels of stress and emotional behaviors along with the fact that the effects of lead exposure are not just during childhood but can lead into adulthood and stick with the student for a long time.”

Jazmine Pacheco (OUSD Student) - “As a student of the OUSD it is frightening to know that lead could be contaminating our water supply. Especially due to the fact that exposure to lead can directly inflict a negative impact on one’s mental health. In a community that is already impacted by various negative factors it is unsettling to know that something as vital as water could also be negatively impacting OUSD students. I hope to hear this issue is resolved soon!”

Lead Contamination

- Community Voice & Concerns

Hector Vasquez - “I am very concerned about this issue. I suggest that any water source that the schools have like fountains, faucets, etc have filters that help keep the lead away. This may be something that you may have done already, but it’s helpful to also consider doing monthly check-ups on these filters so you can switch them out when needed.”

Flor Vasquez - “This lead contamination is very damaging for our community, mainly for our young students. As you may know, low levels of exposure can interfere with thought processes which can lower children’s learning ability and can cause attention and behavioral problems. I hope the board can fix or find a solution to this immediately.”
