



- · Project-Based (East) Internship-Based (West)





Exploring College, Career, and Community Options

- Offerings:
 - Peralta Institute: six-week CTE course/workshop at a Peralta College campus
 - Internships
 - Career Training Experiences
 - Skilled Trades Program
- Opportunities and support from pathway to maximize access and success
- Weekly professional development seminars taught by Advisors (teachers, school staff)
- Student stipend incentive, \$1,000 / student on average
- Focus on technical skill development and "soft skills" around professional communication and time management
