











Grade K i-Ready Diagnostic Reading Spring Mid-Above & Fall-Spring Growth 3 Year Comparison



Grade 1 i-Ready Diagnostic Reading Spring Mid-Above & Fall-Spring Growth 3 Year Comparison



Grade 2 i-Ready Diagnostic Reading **Spring Mid-Above & Fall-Spring Growth** 3 Year Comparison


Grade 2 Mid-Above and Growth


Grade 3 i-Ready Diagnostic Reading Spring Mid-Above & Fall-Spring Growth 3 Year Comparison

Grade 3 Mid-Above and Growth




Grade 4 i-Ready Diagnostic Reading Spring Mid-Above & Fall-Spring Growth 3 Year Comparison

Grade 5 i-Ready Diagnostic Reading Spring Mid-Above & Fall-Spring Growth 3 Year Comparison





