

Dewey Academy High school will receive an award of \$6,150 (we subtracted the \$900 because funds can no longer be used to pay for chaperones or presenters) to be used during the 2024-2025 academic year to support students/educators in the Healthcare pathway by hosting the following:

- 4-year university (CSU/UC) field trips with pathway-specific activities
- Project-based learning experiences on the college campus
