Activities mentioned that parents would like to fund at the middle school level

 - Noted: We have a donation fund to pay for tutors

- Middle school sports
 - Noted: Expanded Learning and ASES helps support MS sports; Community School grant application
- Mental health
 - Noted: Our current Measure G1 funding supports counseling at middle school level
- College applications and scholarship support
 - We have obtained CCAP grant to partially support college and career counseling
 - Cash for College supported by our counseling department

February 6, 2025 Staff Meeting

- Staff overwhelmingly support the 1% raise for staff retention.
- Staff asked what it currently funds and it was explained that it currently funds a partial middle school counselor which aligns with our LCAP goal number 3 that aims to improve school climate, community engagement and mental health with specific emphasis at the middle school level.
- Staff asked if the middle school counselor supported our Wellness Center and it was explained that yes she does.
- A staff member asked if Measure G1 could fund Dual Enrollment and it was explained that Measure G1 was specifically apportioned for middle school and dual enrollment is a high school program.
- Staff comments supported counselors because our students have many family and socio emotional traumas and as a main driver of our Academic Support Groups and restorative practices.

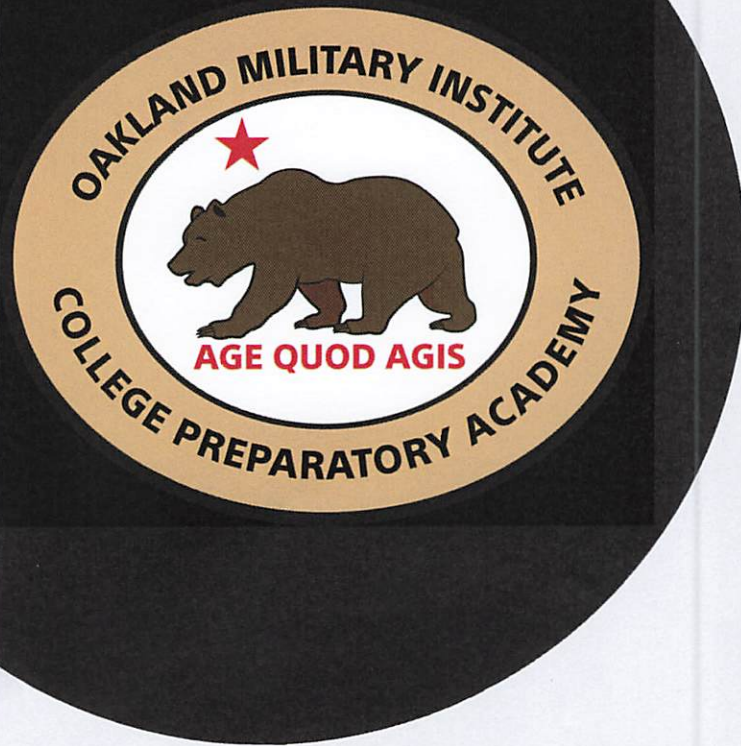

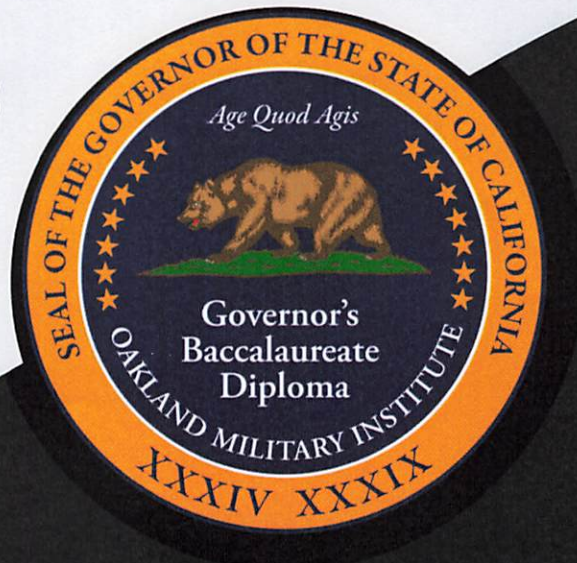
