Background:

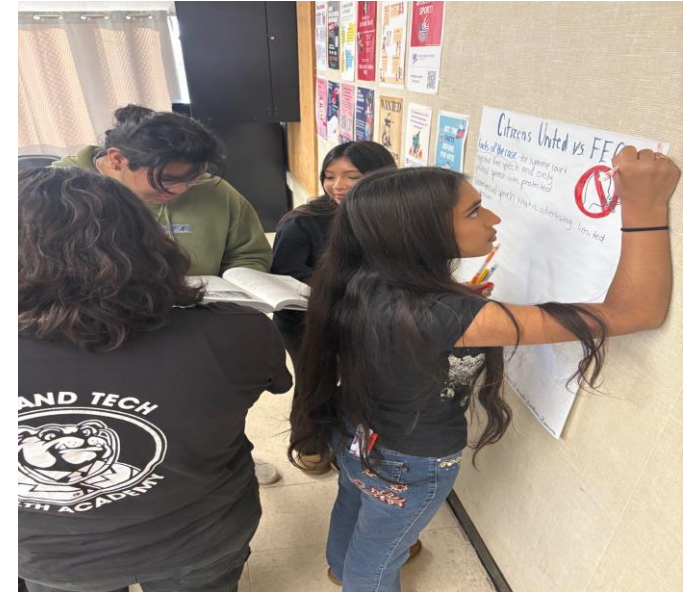
The adoption is an opportunity to:

- Provide students with frequent opportunities to develop core **Historical thinking and Writing skills**
- Provide clear **guidance** and multiple **practice AP questions and practice writing prompts**
- Support social studies **literacy and discourse** skills



Selection Process

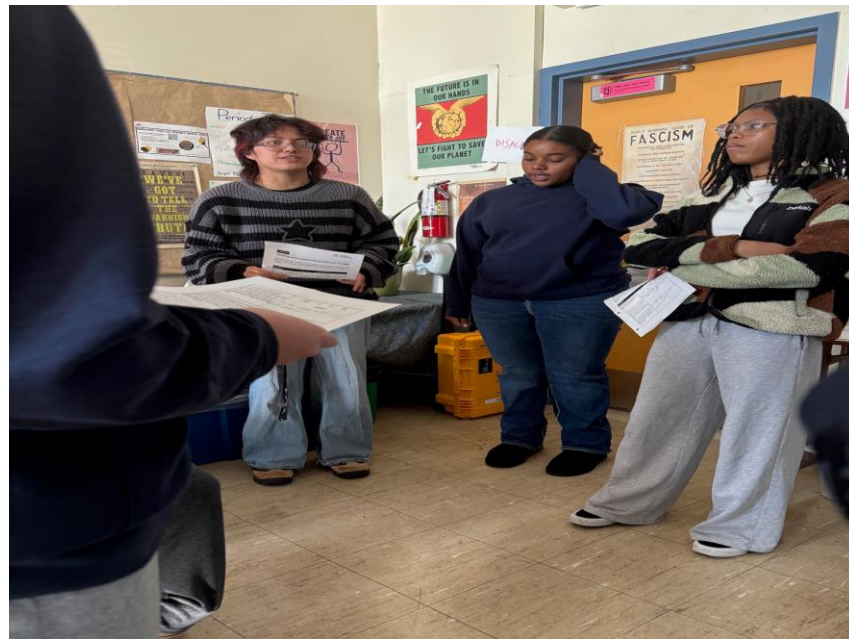
- **Fall 2023:** College Board updated their Course and Exam Descriptions (CEDs) for AP Social Sciences
- **Spring 2024:** Convened a committee of social studies teachers to
 - Listen to vendor presentations
 - Review and score materials of each vendor
- **Fall 2024:** Selected ONE option to pilot against the current text
- **Trial and Adoption Committee:** 3 AP Social Teachers from Oakland Technical High School and Skyline
- **Additional stakeholder input:** Coordinators and Students
