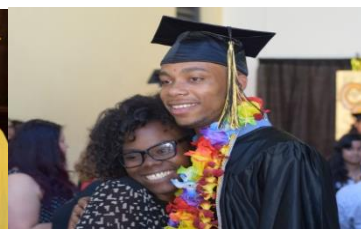

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**Question #1: What specific evidence of progress in *pathway development* are you most proud to highlight?**

### **Highlights of pathway development:**

- Full access for focal group, students with IEPs
- Advisory Board progress
- Digital portfolio websites across whole school
- Formation of student groups for feedback and guidance
- Some internships in IT/web development for 11th graders; certifications in the works

### **Evidence as shown in Program of Study and WBL Plan:**

- Continued Peralta Summer Institute participation
- Portfolio Defense and Student-Led Conferences that include postsecondary plans
- Beginnings of Interdisciplinary projects
- WBL Additions: Mock interviews, Staff panel, LinkedIn workshop

## Reflections on 2024-2025 so far

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**Question #2: What might be some challenges that you encountered in making progress toward your three-year goals?**

**Primary Challenge:** Teacher retention and pathway flourishing

**Actions:**

- Student surveys and focal groups to meet student needs and interests
- Ongoing professional development and teacher collaboration time
- Continued expansion of WBL continuum to advance career-readiness learning
- Regular feedback from Advisory Board

**Additional Evidence from Program of Study and WBL Plan:**

- Limited interdisciplinary projects with current software & systems courses
- Students concurrently taking ICT and DMA classes

# Pathway Name: Software & Systems Development

## Reflections on 2024-2025 so far

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**Question #3: What insights have you gained through the development of the new plan for 2025-2026, and how do you intend to apply this learning to achieve your school-wide goals?**

### **Insights:**

- Student surveys showed decreased interest in ICT, increased interest in DMA
- Pathway cannot thrive without established teachers
- Adjustments will need to be made to Program of Study for new pathway, but the foundation is in place

### **Next Steps and use of funds:**

- Complete Pathway Change
- Pathway team will work to ensure smooth and quick transition of pathway themes
- Earn & Learn collaboration to support WBL and additional partnerships
- Teacher planning time for more integration of pathway theme
