## LPS Oakland R&D: Commitment to Equity & Student Success

Location: East Oakland Grade Levels: 9–12 Enrollment: 171

Mission: Create inclusive, empowering, and college-preparatory learning experiences for students that equip them for success in college, career, and community leadership.








### LPS Oakland R&D's Dual Enrollment Success

<b>Grade Level</b>	College Dual Enrollment 2023-2024
Grades 11 & 12	Over 75% of students successfully completed at least one college course.
Grade 12	Over 50% of students successfully completed two or three college courses.

**Key Point:** LPS Oakland R&D demonstrates strong student engagement and success in dual enrollment programs, with the majority of Grade 12 students earning college-level coursework credits. This achievement highlights the school's commitment to equipping students with advanced skills and opportunities for post-secondary success.

## LPS DMMA: Reflections on 2024-2025 so far Overcoming Barriers to Pathway Success

- X Over Reliance on DE courses as foundation of CTE pathway
  - ⇒ Designed DMMA completer sequence with year long CTE courses
- X Dual Enrollment Access & Support
  - ⇒ Embedded course facilitators and revised master schedule
- ➤ Work-Based Learning (WBL) and Career Prep Gaps
  - ⇒ Designed WBL Career Practicum and Whole School Career Launch
- > PBL & Linked Learning Instructional Consistency
  - ⇒ PD bi-weekly on Linked Learning (LL) & PBL; ILT → GLT LL cohorts









## LPS DMMA: Looking Ahead to 2025-26 Strategic Learning & Next Steps

- **Cross-content integration** to connect career goals with pathway coursework
- - \* Student voice & choice in opportunities for customized industry projects
- Deepening PBL Integration Across Subjects


