



LPS Oakland R&D's Dual Enrollment Success

Grade Level	College Dual Enrollment 2023-2024
Grades 11 & 12	Over 75% of students successfully <mark>completed at least one college course.</mark>
Grade 12	<mark>Over 50%</mark> of students successfully <mark>completed two or three college courses.</mark>

Key Point: LPS Oakland R&D demonstrates strong student engagement and success in dual enrollment programs, with the majority of Grade 12 students earning college-level coursework credits. This achievement highlights the school's commitment to equipping students with advanced skills and opportunities for post-secondary success.






The Challenge — Identifying Barriers to College & 4 Career Readiness




Previous Student Outcomes 2021-2022 (pre-CCI)

Students participating in internships during school year








The Impact – 46% Growth in One Year: What the Data Shows


