
23-24 Annual report highlights: Dropout rates

Dropout rates have decreased for both OUSD (10%, down 3.9 percentage points) and charter schools (6.6%, down 0.5 percentage points).

23-24 Annual report highlights: Graduation rates



Graduation rates are at their highest since Measure N, with OUSD's class of 2024 reaching 79.5%, a 15.3 percentage point increase since the launch of Measure N.

Charter schools report a 92.4% graduation rate, a 0.4 percentage point increase during the same time period.

23-24 Annual report highlights: Recovery from the Pandemic


Since 2020-21, the rate of graduates completing A-G requirements in OUSD schools has increased by 4 percentage points from 57.3% to 61.3%.

For Charters the A-G completion rate for graduates has increased by 5.9 percentage points from 78.8% to 84.7%.
