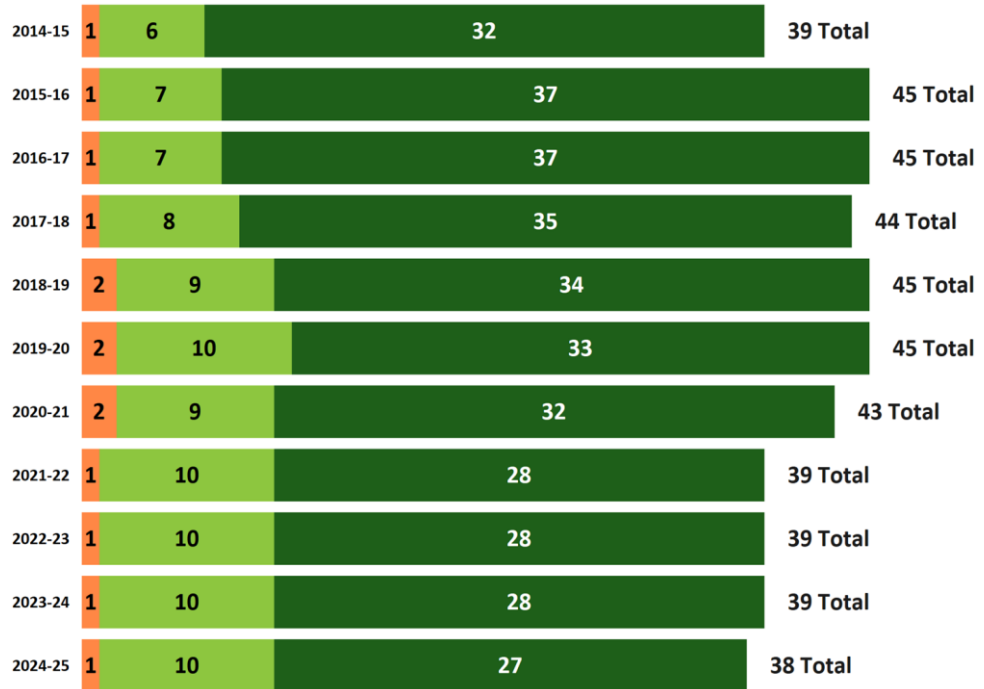

- Any slide which references “Oakland Charters” includes information from **all** charter schools located in Oakland (including other authorizers). “OUSD Charters” includes **only** charter schools authorized by OUSD.

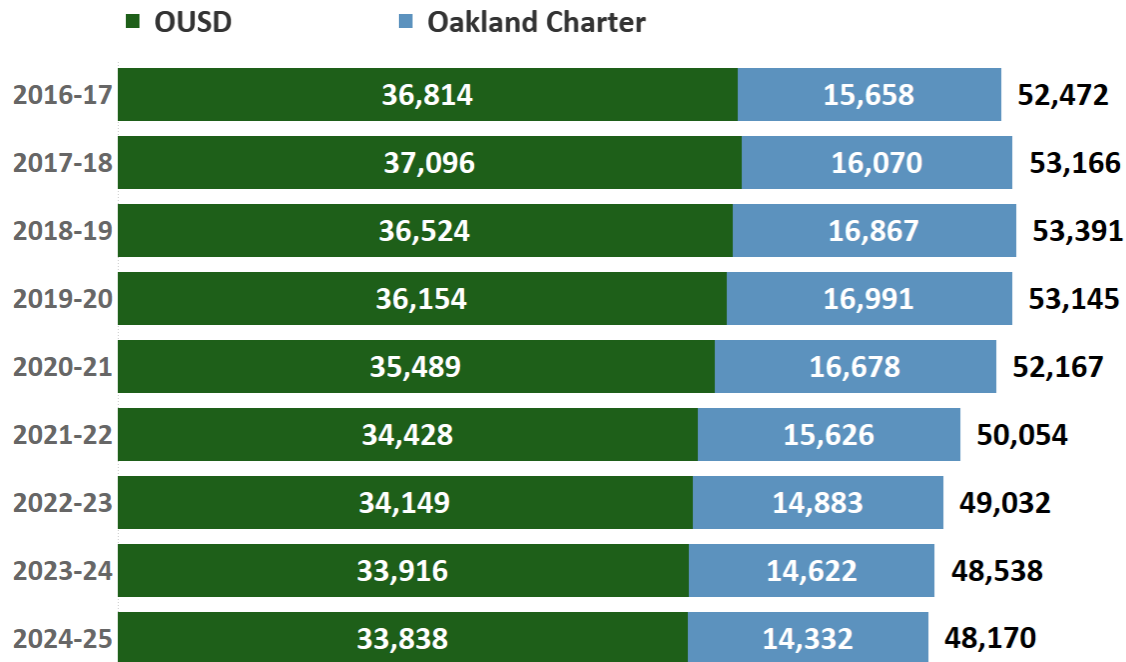
Charter Schools in Oakland, by Authorizer

In 2024-25 there are 38 total charter schools in Oakland. The 27 authorized by OUSD is the lowest number in the past 10 years, while the number authorized by ACOE has slowly increased then remained constant.



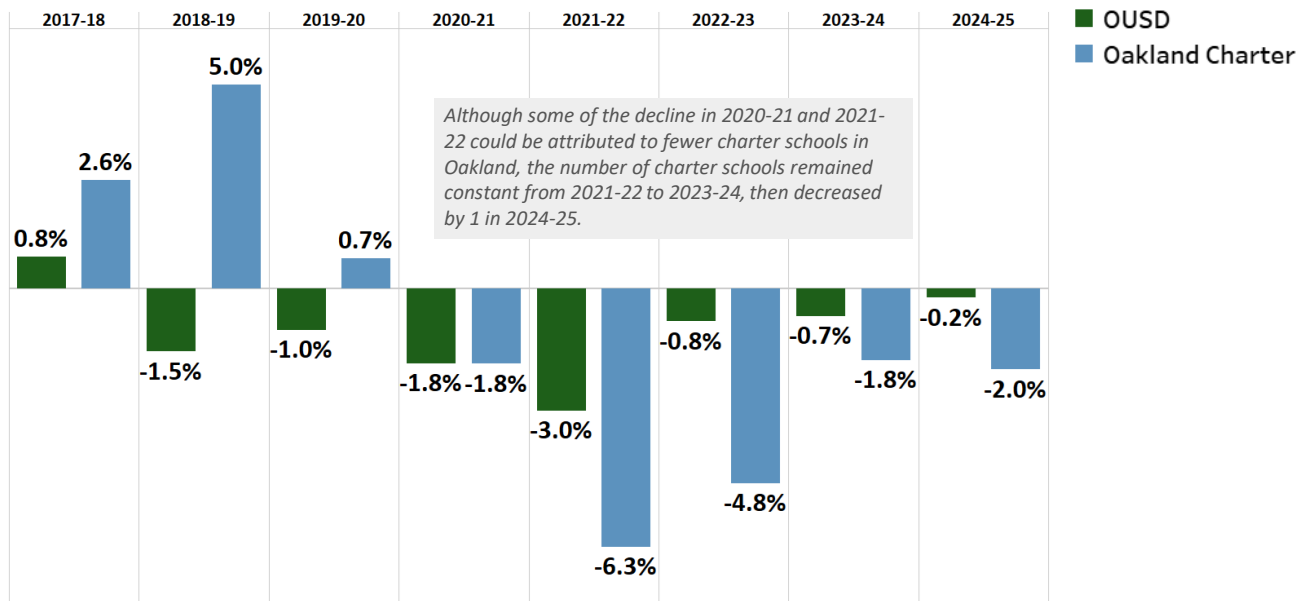
Total Enrollment Over Time, District and Oakland Charter

According to data submitted on Census Day 2024, total Oakland charter enrollment continued to decline for the sixth consecutive year since 2019-2020.



Enrollment Percent Change Over Time

On the whole, Oakland charter school enrollment was growing year to year until 2020-2021. Both Oakland charters and OUSD experience declining enrollment with the onset of the pandemic. Oakland charter schools had been decreasing at a greater rate than OUSD.



Oakland Charter School Enrollment

Of the 38 charter schools in Oakland, **26 schools saw decreases in enrollment this year (compared to 22 last year)**. Of the 12 schools that increased, 4 schools (below) increased by 10% or more. Of the 26 that decreased, 6 decreased by 10% or more.

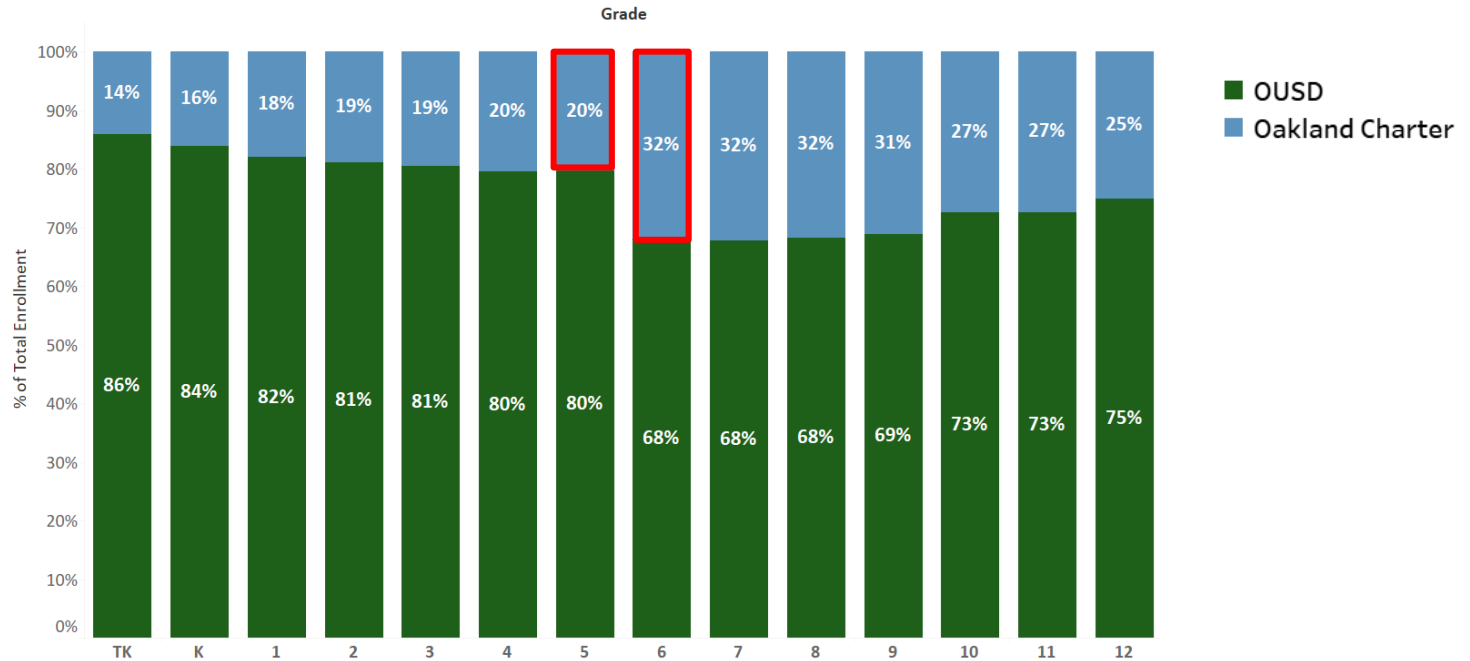

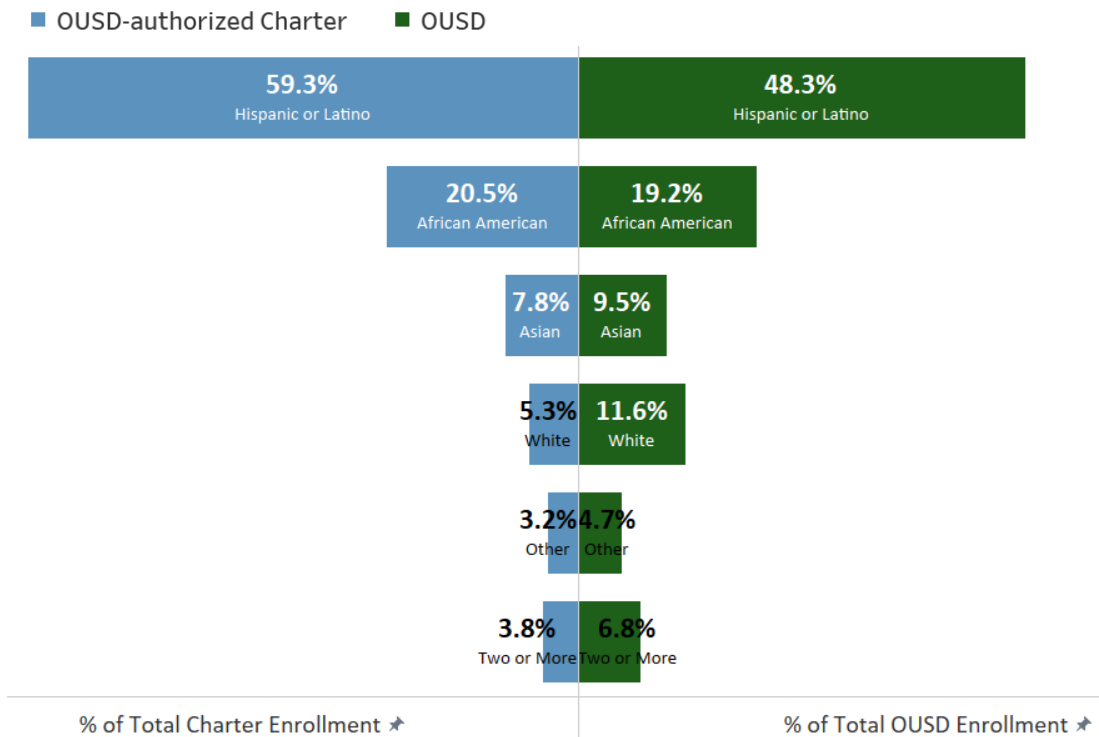

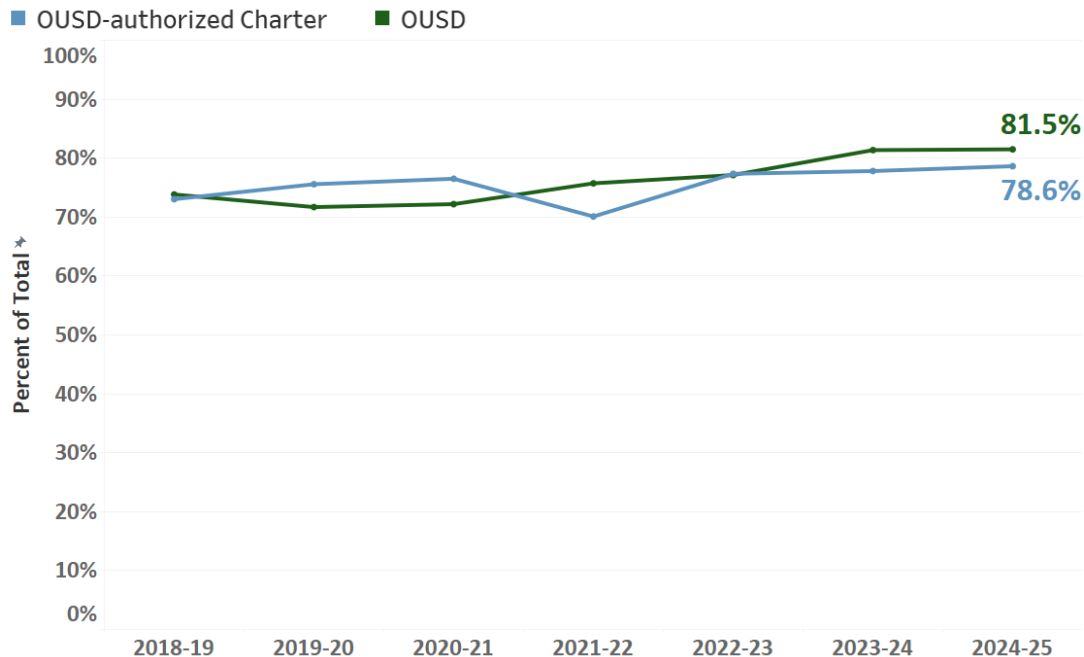

2024-25 Demographics: Race and Ethnicity



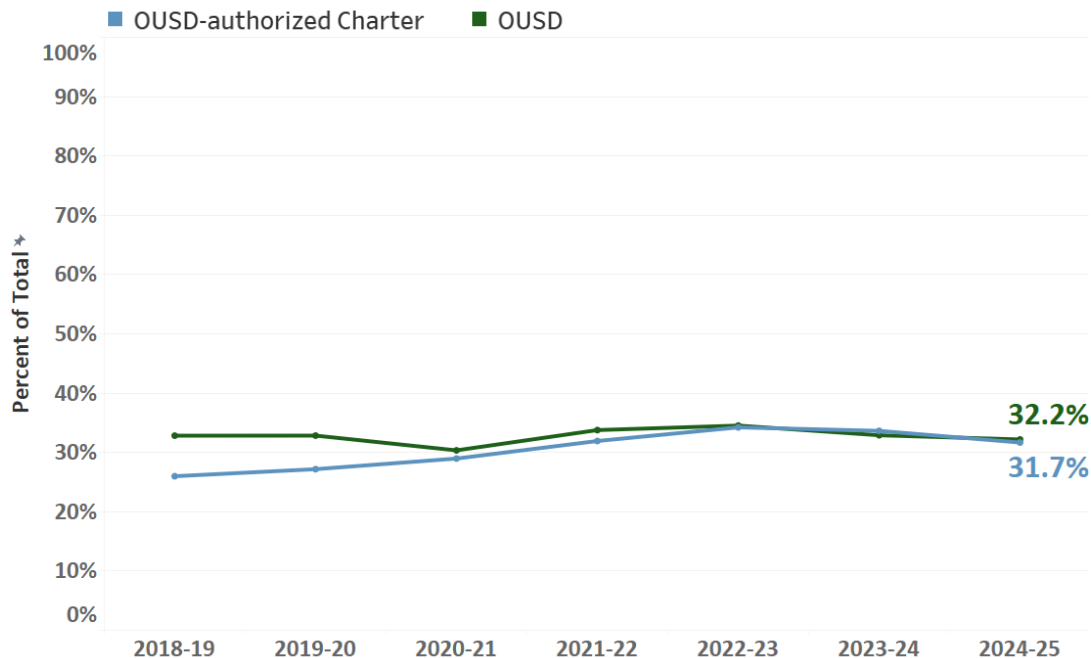
2024-25 Demographics: Socioeconomically Disadvantaged Students

Over the past 7 years, OUSD charter schools generally have had a higher percentage of socioeconomically disadvantaged (SED) students than OUSD, until 2021-22, the proportion of SED students enrolled at OUSD charter schools fell below or equal to the proportion of students enrolled in OUSD.



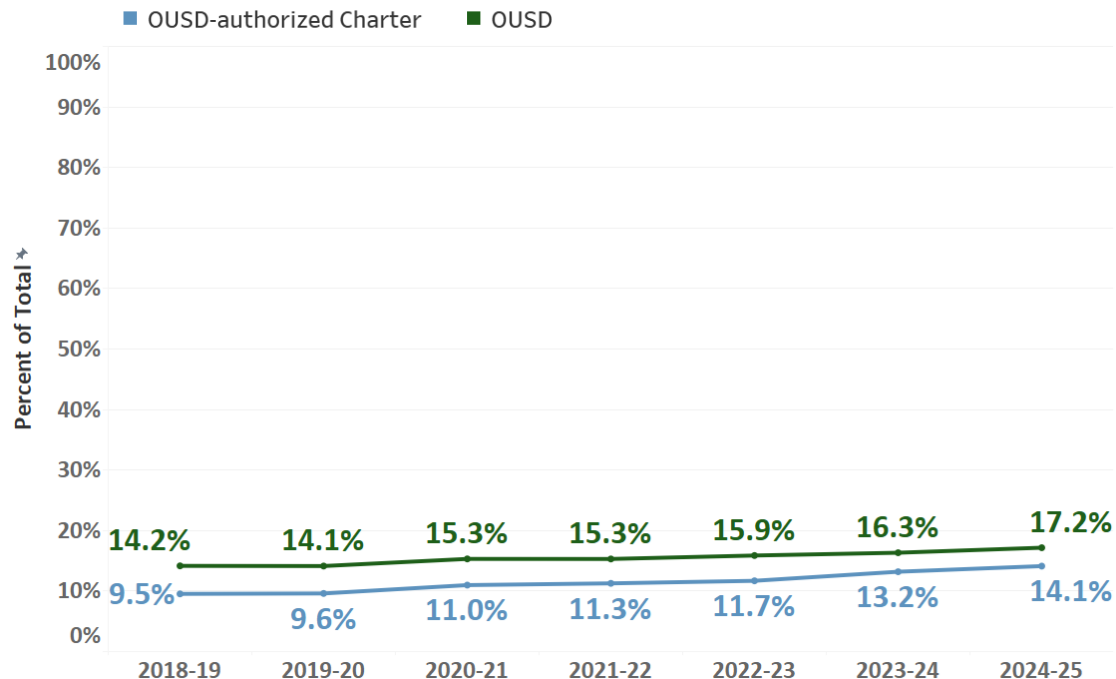
2024-25 Demographics: English Language Learners

Over the years, the gap between OUSD and OUSD charter school's English Language Learner (ELL) enrollment percentage has narrowed . In 2024-25, the proportion of ELL students enrolled in OUSD charters was marginally lower than the proportion of ELL students enrolled in OUSD.



2024-25 Demographics: Students with Disabilities

The percentage of OUSD students with disabilities generally hovers about 4 percentage points higher than the percentage of OUSD charter school students with disabilities, with the exception of the last couple of years where the gap was about 3 percentage points.
