Project Narrative

EFG Champions

Environment, Food, and Garden Champions are OUSD teacher leaders that hold garden stewardship, food education, and environmental literacy at their school sites. There are 80 EFGs, including almost one at every school.

In this stipend role, the EFG Champion leads garden management, maintenance, and use of the school site's existing educational garden space(s) and its harvest. They connect their school garden, school food, Harvest of the Month and other programs together to promote access to nutritious food like fruits and vegetables at school for students, families, and staff.

EFGs are managed by the Central Kitchen, Education Program and Instructional Farm (The Center) and receive professional development, technical assistance, garden supplies, seeds and starts from our green house, food for Harvest of the Month taste tests and recipe sharing and promotional educational signage for the school produce bars, cafeteria bulletin boards, school gardens, outdoor spaces and classrooms.
