

- 4-Year Cohort Graduation Rate: 5.1% increase from 2022 to 2024
- A-G Completion: 4.1% increase from 2022 to 2024














High School Network Wins: Dropout & CC Indicator

- **Dropout Rate: 7.2%** decrease from 2022 to 2024
- College/Career Indicator: 3.9% increase from 2022 to 2024








2024-2025 KPI's: iReady

- 33% of students met their iReady growth goals from Fall to Spring administration








