## **Purpose of the Visits**

The Purpose of the visits is to evaluate progress of sites that were recently elevated from Conditionally Approved to Approved.

The visits serve as check-ins on the enabling conditions for Linked Learning success that were previously key concerns for these two sites, such as:

- Staff retention and training
- Principal support and leadership stability
- Program coherence and evidence of implementation
- School-specific success metrics from EIP assessment



## **Key Wonderings: Leadership Public School**

- Effects of Staff turnover as majority have 2 years of experience in Leadership Public School or less. They also have a new Principal this year
- Proof of implementation beyond their reported plans
- Evidence of progress on Areas for Progress Monitoring

#### **Guiding Questions:**

- What is current staff retention and quality of training on Linked Learning implementation?
- What type of support is the new principal receiving around Linked Learning pathway development?
- Are action plans and metrics of success being implemented as promised to the county board?



## **Key Wonderings: Metwest**

- Articulation of Linked Learning vs. Big Picture approach
- Evidence of progress on Areas for Progress Monitoring
- Clarity on entrepreneurship pathway integration

#### **Guiding Questions:**

- How are teachers being trained to integrate Linked Learning schoolwide?
- How are Entrepreneurship CTE standards embedded or integrated into classes, Advisory, and internships? Where does the entrepreneurship pathway "live"?
- What is the coherent thread that aligns Big Picture and Linked Learning?
- Are there limits to student experiences, or is there a true umbrella vision?

 Use findings to inform early intervention before formal EIP review in Spring.
