## **Student Health and Safety**

SB 404 (Caballero): Hazardous Materials: Metal Shredding Facilities

This bill would revise and reduce the environmental oversight of metal shredding facilities, shifting regulatory authority away from local agencies to the state Department of Toxic Substances Control. In addition, the bill allows metal shredding facilities to reclassify the waste they create from hazardous to nonhazardous, which reduces the environmental safety regulations they are required to follow.

**Note:** There is a metal shredding facility in Oakland, Radius Recycling (formerly known as Shnitzer Steel), that is within a 3-mile radius of approximately 65 schools and preschools.

Recommended Position: Oppose
