Subject Initial Public Hearing – Aspire College Academy Charter Petition and Request for Material Revision – Grades TK-5, Enrollment Increase, Effective July 1, 2026

Ask of the Board Board members will have the opportunity to ask the lead charter petitioners questions following the presentation.

Background On June 11 the OUSD Board approved a material revision from Aspire Triumph Technology Academy (“Triumph Academy”) to change location from 3200 62nd Avenue, Oakland, CA 94605, to the same location as Aspire College Academy (“ACA”), 8030 Atherton St, Oakland, CA 94605. The OUSD Board approved Triumph Academy’s material revision and it served as the first step of a proposed merger between Triumph Academy and ACA.

ACA submitted a material revision request on August 1, 2025. The proposed material revision serves as the final step of the merger between Aspire College Academy and Aspire Triumph Technology Academy into a single school entity. Through the merger, the material revision requests to increase ACA’s enrollment from 242 to 362 in the 2026-27 school year, 268 to 382 in the 2027-28 school year, 266 to 410 in the 2028-29 school year, 272 to 416 in the 2029-30 school year, and 296 to 416 in the 2030-31 school year.

The OUSD Office of Charter Schools is conducting an evaluation of the material revision request and will present their findings and recommendation to the District Board for a vote.

Discussion Board members will have the opportunity to ask the lead charter petitioners questions at the Initial Public Hearing.
