# **Charter School Renewal Overview**

#### **Background**

Every 5 years (typically), a Charter School must submit a renewal petition to their authorizer in order to continue operating. The authorizer, the OUSD Board of Education, must evaluate the renewal petition based on criteria outlined in California Education Code and the school's Renewal Tier placement. The Board must vote within 90 days of submission to approve or deny the petition.

#### **COVID-19 Impact on Charter Renewal**

Due to the lack of Dashboard data after COVID, the State legislature extended all charters' terms by a total of **three years.** Therefore, all OUSD-authorized charter schools that are up for renewal this fall are currently in **year 8** of their charter term.



## **Academic Performance - English Language Arts**




ELA Proficiency has increased post-pandemic for the middle and high school grade spans, and decreased for the elementary school grade span.




Between 2021-22 and 2023-24, all student groups saw a **net** increase in average DFS.

Math proficiency increased for each grade span, but remains lower than the OUSD average.











**Academic Performance - Math**

2023-24 Four Year Grad Rate




2023-24 A-G Rate

### **English Learner Progress**




The percentage of students progressing at least one ELPI Level remained consistent in 2022-23 but decreased in 2023-24.

Latitude's fiscal health is adequate, with a healthy fund balance and realistic budget projections.









The charter petition included a reasonably comprehensive description, per State standards, of the 15 required elements outlined in California Education Code.



There were no substantiated complaints related to noncompliance with suspension, expulsion, or involuntary disensollment procedures and no evidence in the State-provided enrollment data which suggests the Charter School is not serving all students who wish to attend.

# Staff Recommendation

#### The OUSD Office of Charter Schools recommends APPROVAL

with a Fiscal Benchmark to track audit finding clearance and a Performance Benchmark to track ELA progress.

#### **Strengths**

- Schoolwide improvement in both ELA and Math proficiency in most recent three years.
- Improvement in average DFS for all student groups in both ELA and Math in most recent three years.
- Majority of grade levels and student groups made at least one year's progress per verified data results in 2023-24
- First graduating class had high graduation and A-G completion rates.
- Post-pandemic decline in chronic absenteeism.
- Stable and sustainable enrollment with healthy fund balance.

#### Challenges

- Schoolwide average proficiency and DFS remained below District average in both Math and ELA in most recent year, with ELA receiving a Red indicator on the 2024 Dashboard.
- ELs making progress declined in most recent year, with Red on the ELPI Dashboard indicator.
- Low high school Math proficiency: 0% in 2021-22 and 2022-23, and 6% most recently.
- Most recent audit identified a material weakness.
- Approximately 53% of teaching assignments considered "Ineffective".
