**Action Requested** Approval by the Board of Education of Resolution No. 2526-0195 - Application for Provisional Internship Permit – California Commission on Teacher Credentialing – Named Employees for School Year 2025-2026:

1. Johanna Bliss, K-5<sup>th</sup> grade Temporary Art Teacher, Joaquin Miller Elementary School;
2. James Smart, 9<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> grade Teacher RSP Mild/Moderate Support Needs, McClymonds High School;
3. Tanna Hall, K-5<sup>th</sup> grade World Languages Teacher, Saquoia Elementary School; and
4. Israel Gallardo, 9<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> grade Social Science Teacher, Madison Park Academy High School.

**Background** According to Title 5 Sections 80021-80021.1, the Provisional Internship Permit (PIP) was created in response to the phasing out of emergency permits and became effective on July 1, 2005. It allows an employing agency to hire an individual who has not yet met the subject matter competence requirement needed to enter an internship program. Prior to requesting a PIP, the employment agency must verify that a diligent search has been made, and a fully credentialed teacher cannot be found.

The PIP is only available at the request of an employing agency. Individuals may not apply directly to the Commission for this document. Holders of the PIP are restricted to service with the employment agency requesting the permit. An employing agency is defined as a California public school district, county office of education, non-public school, charter school, or statewide agency.

The PIP is available in the areas of Multiple Subject, Single Subject, and Education Specialist. Individuals who were issued four or fewer emergency permits may be issued one PIP if the employer requirements have been met. Individuals who were issued five emergency permits do not qualify for the PIP.

**Discussion**

The Board of Education, exercising the power of the Governing Board, may approve an application seeking a Provisional Internship Permit from the Commission on Teacher Credentialing, as may be necessary for certain certificated employees of the district so they may work in the district for the 2025-2026 school year, as follows:

The current request for the 2025-2026 school year, a Provisional Internship Permit, is being sought for the following employees:

1. Johanna Bliss graduated from Savannah College of Art and Design, Savannah Georgia with a Bachelor's in Fine Arts. This Provisional Intern Permit will allow candidate time to complete the CSET exam and enroll in a University Intern Single Subject program.
2. James Smart graduated from Loyola Marymount University with a Bachelor's in Entrepreneurship. This Provisional Intern Permit will allow candidate time to complete the CSET exam and enroll in a University Intern Education Specialist program.
3. Tanna Hall graduated from San Francisco State with a Bachelor's in Arts. The Provisional Internship Permit will allow candidate time to complete CSET Exams and the requirements for a University SIngle Subject Intern program.
4. Israel Gallardo graduated from University of California, Los Angeles with a Bachelor's in History. This Provisional Intern Permit will allow candidate time to complete the CSET exam and enroll in a University Intern Single Subject program.
