





January

Students are notified if they have tentatively met the first two criteria: 1) Satisfactory attendance & minimum GPA of 2.5 and 2) C or better grade in their US History and Government course. Notification includes their personalized link to the google form application.



February - March

Eligible students continue to work toward completing their civic engagement project hours. **Rolling application - forms can be submitted on an ongoing basis**
*Second notification goes out to eligible students.

April 3rd

DUE DATE: All eligible students complete and submit their self-reflection of their civic-community engagement project and identify their mentor to verify the completion of their hours.

April 17th

DUE DATE: Mentor Verification form

May 8th

Students who have met all 5 criteria are notified, via email, of their achievement and completion of all requirements.

May 15th

State Seals and list of student recipients are delivered to school sites to be affixed to their official diplomas.


