 - Framing from principal: We need to reallocate the carryover funds due to the district hiring freeze. We are not able to use the funding for a RJ Facilitator. Additionally, we will not be able to fund this position next year.
 - Who will be part of the student mural project?
 - Students in each of the art classes will participate in the design of a new campus mural

- Students will work closely with local artists to design and plan the mural
 - What is the plan for the music room?
 - Students are practicing their instruments throughout the day and because the room is adjacent to other classrooms and the Family Resource Center, the noise is a factor. We want to reduce the noise by installing soundproof equipment. This will increase the quality of the sound for musicians as well inside the classroom.
 - Have we partnered with Elevate Oakland in the past?
 - Yes, they bring on additional musical tutors to help students specialize in instruments
