Action Requested and Recommendation

Adoption by the Board of Education, upon recommendation by the Measures N and H Commission of a 2025-2026 Education Improvement Plan/Budget modification for Castlemont High School to modify the following line items: (1) reduce \$9,700.00 Classified Support Salaries: Hire a College & Career Readiness Specialist at .70 FTE by \$9,700.00 to \$0.00, and (2) reduce \$29,000.00 Teacher Salaries: Funds to hire a CTE Teacher, at 0.62 FTE by \$8,800.00 to \$20,200.00, and establish a new strategic action \$18,500.00 Professional Contracted Bus Services: Funds for Charter Bus Rentals for pathway students to visit colleges and universities, as stated in the justification section of the New or Revised Strategic Action Section of the Budget Modification Form.
