Subject Approval of Request for Student Travel

Action Requested Approval of Board Resolution No. 2526-0045, authorizing student travel by school site Oakland Technical High School for sixty three 12th grade students to visit the Oregon Shakespeare Festival, Ashland, OR, for the period of April 15, 2026 through April 17, 2026.

Educational Purpose of Trip In AP Literature we will have spent a good deal of time reading, analyzing, and discussing drama as literature, from Shakespeare's "Macbeth" to modern works such as "A Streetcar Named Desire." But reading is never the same as experiencing live theater, consuming drama as it is intended. These specific plays are an excellent survey for our students to understand the variety that theater offers (Shakespeare, a modern classic, and a contemporary musical) and the magic that gets created by live theater, which is always a missing component in the classroom as we study dramatic texts.

Itinerary and Activities April 15th: leave Oakland Tech after school and drive to Ashland, OR by charter bus and car(s). Check in at hotel, get dinner nearby, and spend night.

April 16th: breakfast at hotel, ride into town for lunch and then a matinee of "A Raisin in the Sun." After performance students will have time to explore the downtown area of Ashland before meeting for a theater Preface for the evening show. The Preface is at 5pm. Afterwards students will get dinner before meeting at the theater for the evening performance of "A Midsummer Night's Dream" at 8pm. After the evening performance, students will be transported back to the hotel for the night.

April 17th: breakfast at the hotel. Charter bus back into town for lunch and a matinee of "Come Far Away." After the performance we will return to the hotel to pack up and check out. We will leave for Oakland late afternoon and arrive around 11pm.

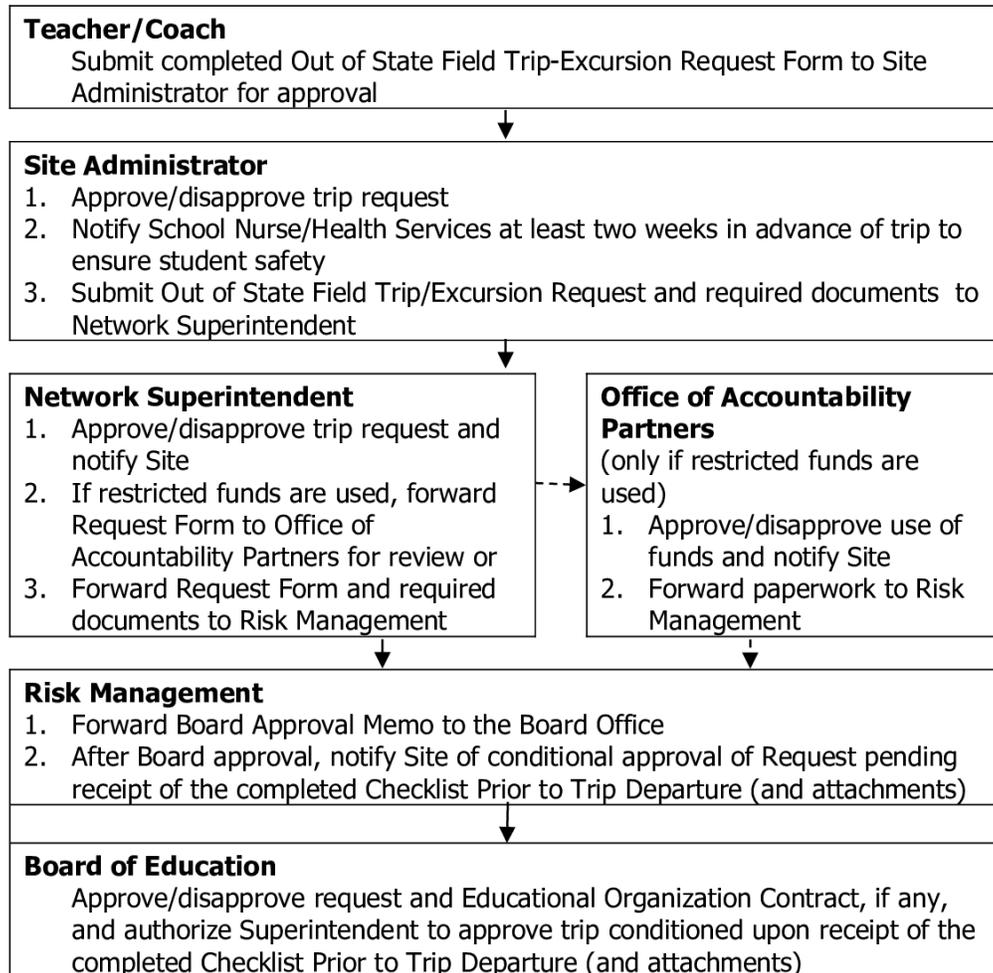

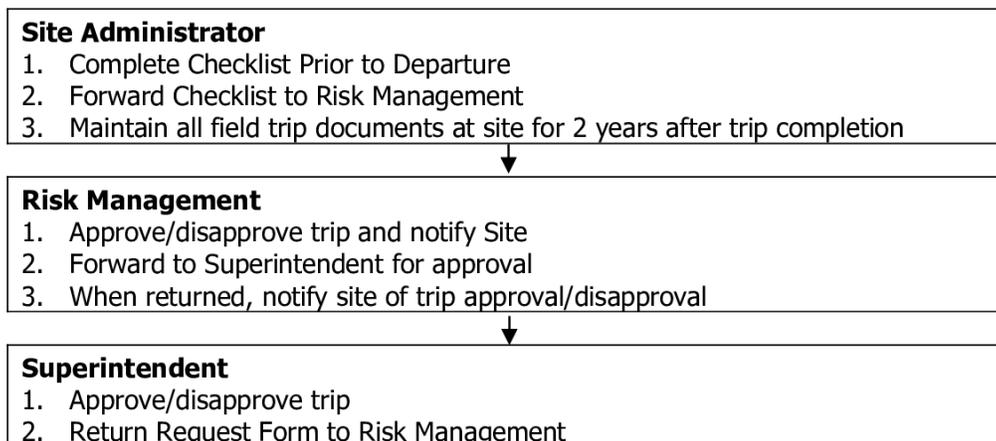

OUT-OF-STATE FIELD TRIP/EXCURSION REQUEST

Basic Directions

This packet is available on the Intranet (School Operations Library) as a fillable-saveable pdf file. If typed, similar fields will populate throughout the packet making it quicker and easier to complete.

1. Requests must be submitted to Network Superintendent no later than **120 days** prior to departure
2. Board approval is required for all out of state trips.
3. Return Health Services Notification Form to the School Nurse or Health Services at the time you are requesting approval for a field trip
4. Use of Restricted Funds requires additional approval by Office of Accountability Partners
5. Obtain fingerprint clearance and complete TB risk assessment (requirements per OUSD AR 1240) for all non-District employee chaperones. (Arrange through ousd.org/volunteers or email volunteers@ousd.org. Continuing volunteer chaperones must be fingerprint cleared at least once every 3 years.)
6. Generally 1:10 Adult to Student ratio is required as provided in OUSD Board Policy 6153
7. Check the Pre-Approved Vendor List for contract and insurance requirements
8. Out-of-state trips have a bifurcated approval system (1) to approve the request and (2) to approve the trip since not all information for the trip approval may available by the deadline for the request. When possible, submit the required documents for the trip approval along with the initial trip request to make the full approval process faster.

TRIP COSTS

Direct educational program costs include admission fees for visits which are part of the program (e.g. museum).

District funds may NOT be used to pay for non-travel pupil expenses for out of state trips. Non-travel pupil expenses include meals, sundries, lodging, etc.

If you want to use District funds to pay for non-travel pupil expenses on an out of state trip, you must first obtain approval for a waiver of Education Code 35330 from the OUSD Board of Education and the State Board of Education.
