24-25 Annual report highlights: A-G Requirements

OUSD graduates meeting A-G requirements

OUSD graduates meeting A-G requirements increased from 61.2% to 62.2% (up 1.0 while charter schools) increased from 84.7% to 92.7% (8.0 percentage points).

Percentage of 9th-grade students on track to graduate

The percentage of 9th-grade students on track to graduate increased for OUSD from 66.6% to **69.2%**, while charter schools remained stable at 84.2%.

Recovery from the Pandemic

Transition period: Moving to long-term sustainability.

Challenges Include:



Graduation rate declined (possible impact of federal funding expiration & student enrollment shifts).



Dropout rate increased.
