We were unable to hire a Project Lead the Way teacher, so we are repurposing funds for the Project Lead the Way curriculum to secure these services and materials through an online vendor.

In the immediate term, the impact will be that the curriculum provider for our 11th grade pathway course (Advanced Placement Computer Science Principles) changed. We had intended to offer that course through Project Lead the Way, but ultimately could not due to challenges staffing our computer science course.

The change for 9th graders is that instead of enrolling in Computer Science Essentials, they are enrolled in a Digital Media course that is infused with Information and Communication Technologies (ICT), our pathway sector.
