Coliseum College Prep Academy

At CCPA, there was an error in the district financial system which did show that a CCPA employee (Spanish teacher) with benefits would cost \$42,000 more than the allocation. We have remedied this by contacting the fiscal team of the error, reducing next year's allocation by \$42,000 and moving forward will double check site allocations against salaries and benefits after the first paychecks in August and September.

Roosevelt Middle School

- In looking at the total allocation + carryover for the 2022-23 school year, here are some highlights:
 - Positive Culture:
 - Student advisors cost \$54,000 less than anticipated. Could be due to less in benefits.
 - \$65,000 Roosevelt couldn't hire a STIP sub and didn't reallocate it.
 - o Art and Music
 - \$10,000 for overtime + benefits for music teacher to expand the after school music program will spend by end of 2022-23 school year
 - \$203,130 in supplies and equipment went unspent. Allocated too much to it, and the music teacher was able to secure some of his own grants.
 - \$38,773 for a music conference for students was not spent music teacher raised funds.
 - \$15,000 for music consultants went unspent music teacher raised funds.
 - Other
 - The principal intentionally planned to use some unspent funds next year as carryover, since the budget will be leaner then.
