Access To District Records

The Governing-Board recognizes the right of citizens to have access to public records of the dDistrict. The Board intends the dDistrict to provide any person reasonable access to the public records of the schools and dDistrict during normal business hours and within the requirements of state and federal law. In the examination occurs in person, sSuch records shall be examined in the presence of the staff member regularly responsible for their maintenance.

The dDistrict may charge for copies of public records or other materials requested by individuals or groups. The charge shall be based on actual costs of duplication, as determined by the Superintendent or designee and in no case shall the cost exceed 10 cents per page plus postage, or 1 cents per page for records routinely produced in multiple copies for distribution, such as copies of an agenda reproduced for a meeting, plus postage. The fee may be waived for media and any person who cannot afford the fee.

Public access shall not be given to records listed as exempt from public disclosure in the California Public Records Act or other statutes.
