 - Get Informed Friday




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Our Pathway:

 - College classes to support their education outside of high school
 - Create more opportunities for students to get into 4 year universities
 - Help students find more information about careers they are interested in

 - Leading the development of an on-site College Experience Program
 - Co-Facilitate Bi-Monthly Pathway Development Meetings with Staff and Pathway Coach
- Teacher Stipends to support out of contract hours worked on Pathway Development
- First Year Program:
 - Critical Thinking and Emotional Intelligence Support Class: Take Time to Think
 - Career Readiness Program supporting career exploration and internship placement: Career Bridge
 - Art Careers Internship ArtEsteem (First Internship for most students)
