# Overview of School

- **Highlights:**
  - Alternative School of Choice
  - Credit Recovery and Dropout Prevention
  - A-G School
  - A,B,C or NM (No D's or F's)
  - Single Pathway School (100% of our students)
  - 50th Year
- **Student Enrollment of School: 77 Students total** (As of March 15th)
- **Highlights of Student Demographics**
  - 51.9% Female Students (40) [Focal Population] and 48.1% Male Students (37)
  - 16.9% English Language Learners (13)
  - 19.5% Special Education Students (15)
- **Schoolwide Systems Supporting Pathway Quality Improvement**
  - Counselor Teacher Mentor System
  - Worker Owned Wednesday
  - Get Informed Friday

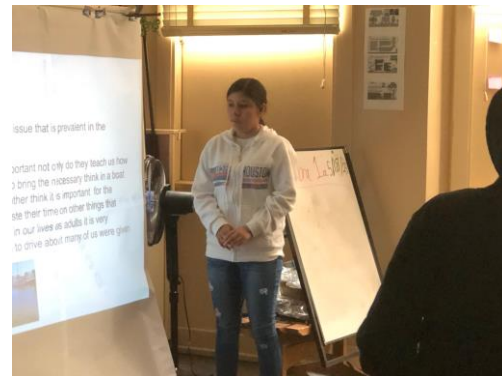


# Our Pathway:

# Reflections on 2023-24

---

- **Highlights of New Strategic Actions for all Goals**
  - College Readiness Program
  - Identify and create objectives for the pipeline
  - Using information from college and career surveys to create exploration visits
- **Everything we do is with the student in mind and will lead to enhanced student success**
  - College classes to support their education outside of high school
  - Create more opportunities for students to get into 4 year universities
  - Help students find more information about careers they are interested in
- **Development of systems that will last after goals are achieved**

  - Leader of the Worker Owned Wednesday Program (Work Based Learning Opportunities)
    - *Annual Back 2 School Social Justice Fair (B2SSJF), Career Fair, End of Program Exhibition*
    - *Development of in-house internships*
      - *Peacekeeping Program*
  - Leading the development of an on-site College Experience Program
  - Co-Facilitate Bi-Monthly Pathway Development Meetings with Staff and Pathway Coach
- **Teacher Stipends to support out of contract hours worked on Pathway Development**
- **First Year Program:**
  - **Critical Thinking and Emotional Intelligence Support Class: Take Time to Think**
  - **Career Readiness Program supporting career exploration and internship placement: Career Bridge**
  - **Art Careers Internship - ArtEsteem - (First Internship for most students)**
